A common disease of the eye is pink-eye, which often occurs in schoolchildren. One or both eyeballs turn quite red and feel irritated. A white discharge also appears in the corners of the eyes. This discharge forms a crust, which can often be seen in the morning after the eyes have been shut all night. This disease spreads rapidly among schoolchildren, usually because they touch their irritated eyes and then touch another



child who in turn touches his eyes. Students with this condition should be sent to the doctor and then told to stay at home to avoid spreading the disease. It can be fairly easily cured with drugs, but if left unattended can become serious. There are many other diseases of the eyes, some of which are serious and can cause blindness. At any sign of eye infection, a student should be sent to a doctor.
